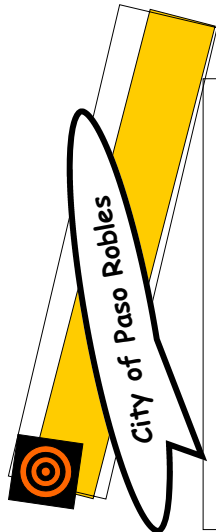

Friends Donation Policy

Donations of books and magazines* are gratefully accepted during the Library's business hours

BOOKS and MAGAZINES

Please keep in mind that books and magazines must be in good condition and of current interest. Our experience tells us that the following are not sellable items:

- Books that are worn, torn, dirty or otherwise in poor condition
- Textbooks, law books, medical and professional reference books more than two years old

When you deliver your items, please let us know if you would like your books back if they are not to be added to the Library's collection (that is, if you do not want them sold in the Friends Store). If you would like a receipt for your donation, please let us know. We can issue a receipt for the number of books donated, but we are prohibited from putting a dollar value on donations. Due to processing limitations, we cannot accept more than 2 boxes or bags of books at a time.

*Weekly magazines up to 3 weeks old and monthly magazines up to 2 years old. Unless the Library is actively soliciting large *National Geographic* collections, which they keep for children's school reports, we do not have the capacity to store them.
