Come see the first Boeing Airliner & Airmail airplane

Painstakingly restored, the only Boeing 40 flying in the world & the oldest Boeing flying

This airplane crashed on a mountain in 1928 and not flown again until 2008

Accompanying the Boeing is a 1930 Stearman 4E Jr. Speedmail built for carrying Air Mail
and see the rare, the only 1928 Laird LBC 300 Biplane flying.
