ARTISTS North County students, grades 6-12, eligible

MEDIA Oil, acrylic, watercolor, gouache, pencil, pastel, ink, charcoal, crayon or mixed. No computer graphics.

ENTRIES

Must be original and done by the artist shown on the entry form

Must be ready to hang (wire for framed or heavy pieces, Velcro on back for matted only)

Must remain in exhibition for duration of exhibit

Artist may choose to make artwork available for purchase or not

Library has the right to refuse works not meeting the rules of entry.

NUMBER Two works may be entered

FORMAT All works must be matted, backed with Velcro strips, or framed with wire. Stretched canvases with finished (painted) edges will be accepted. Maximum size is 18" x 24," including mat or frame.

FEES \$5 for up to 2 entries; make checks payable to the Paso Robles Library Foundation.

SELECTION Two works by one artist may possibly be selected; others may not be selected at all. Final selection is at the discretion of the juror.

FORMS The Entry Form is to be submitted upon delivery of artwork. An Entry Tag must be attached to the back of each work. Additional copies of this prospectus can be obtained at the Paso Robles City Library, 1000 Spring Street, or online, www.prcity.com/library, or by calling Suzanne, at 237-3870.

LIABILITY Entries will be handled with care. Neither the City Library, the Library Foundation, nor the City of Paso Robles is liable for any damage or loss. Any insurance must be purchased by submitting artist.

JACK JOHNSON, Juror

Jack Johnson spent his career as an advertising art director, a production illustrator, conceptual artist, and art director for feature films, including *Edward Scissorhands*, *Toys*, *Jurassic Park III*, *Pleasantville*, *The Perfect Storm*, and *Big Fish*. As an illustrator, he did sketches and paintings of sets before they were built. His own paintings have won major awards in numerous regional and national shows.

Brushmarks, an annual juried art exhibit for teens, was Johnson's idea originally and became a reality in 2007. He has provided the awards and encouragement for aspiring teen artists ever since.
