WHY

In the event of a large-scale disaster, the normal Emergency Response Agencies that serve you will be overwhelmed and they might not be able to assist you for up to 72 hours (it's simply, a supply and demand issue).

WHAT

CERT is a 20-hour "hands-on" course that teaches individuals to be better prepared in the event of a major disaster, and to form into effective neighborhood teams to assist others. In the CERT training class you will learn about how and when to turn off your **Utilities; Firefighting skills; Medical skills; Hazardous Materials & Terrorism awareness; light Search and Rescue techniques;** and most importantly, you'll learn **SELF RELIANCE**.
