Needs: That the City Council approve or reject the request of James Cutchin to construct fencing on City right-of-way.

- Facts:
1. The City Council accepted road dedications by Resolution for Larkfield Place on February 27, 1989.
  2. Tract 1185 lies to the north of the Cutchin property. The backyards are all fenced with a 6' high board fence except Lot 7, they have a 4' high open lath fence. The property owner would like to keep it open for the view. Mr. Cutchin would like to construct a 6' fence 1' into the City's right-of way.




Dear Mr. McCarthy:

This letter is to request permission to erect privacy fence on the property herein described. **The fence would not exceed 6 feet in height and I will be responsible for any upkeep required.**


