Annie discussed a form received from the state regarding the annual listing of Foundation officers. Jim Knecht advised Annie about the form, and she will complete the form and return it.


Betsy told the Board about the anticipated juried art show that could be held in June. Cash prizes would be offered, and Betsy gave a brief highlight about juried selections and
