SUBJECT: Parking Restrictions (red curb) and Traffic Controls (stop sign) in the vicinity of Vendels Circle and North Ramada Drive
DATE: November 2, 2004

NEEDS: For the City Council to consider new parking restrictions (red curb) at the 1380 block of Vendels Circle near Firestone Walker Brewery and Nu-Way Cleaners, modification of traffic controls (stop signs) and red curb removal on north Ramada Drive near the Vendels Circle intersection.

FACTS:

1. The City received a letter and petition from Firestone Walker Brewing Company requesting red curb at four areas in front of their business and two areas across the street.
2. At their September 24, 2004 meeting the Streets and Utilities committee discussed the issue and, after hearing dissenting views, directed staff to schedule a meeting with business people in the vicinity and attempt to come to consensus regarding parking restrictions and other issues.
3. As directed, staff met with the business owners on Vendels Circle and worked out changes to existing parking restrictions, traffic controls, and addition of new parking restrictions agreeable to all.
4. The Streets and Utilities Committee reviewed the changes at their meeting of October 22, 2004 and voted 2-0 to recommend approval of the changes as presented.

**ANALYSIS &
CONCLUSION:**

At the September 24, 2004 meeting of the S&U Committee, it became apparent that all affected parties were not in agreement with the request. The committee continued the agenda item and directed staff to meet with all parties and attempt to work out an agreement acceptable to all.

City staff (Chief Cassidy, Charles Lorenzen & Dennis Fansler) met on site with representatives of Firestone Brewery, Nu-Way Cleaners and The Gallery on September 20, 2004. The group discussed parking restrictions, traffic controls (stop sign) and potential removal of parking controls (red curb) on North Ramada. Consensus was reached, documented (see signatures on attached map) and the list of the following changes was recommended for approval by the S&U Committee at their meeting of October 22, 2004.

- Addition of 48 feet of red curb in front of Firestone Walker Brewery (see attached map)
- Addition of 45 feet of red curb in front of Nu-way Cleaners (see attached map)
- Removal of approximately 22 feet of red curb north of the Vendels/North Ramada intersection and removal of approximately 22 feet of red curb south of the Vendels/North Ramada intersection (see attached map).
- Relocate traffic controls (Stop sign and stop bar) on westbound Vendels Drive at the Intersection of North Ramada further west (see attached map).

RESOLUTION NO. 04-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES
APPROVING PARKING RESTRICTION ADDITIONS AND MODIFICATIONS AND
THE ADDITION OF TRAFFIC CONTROLS ON VENDELS CIRCLE

WHEREAS, The City received a letter and petition from Firestone Walker Brewing Company requesting red curb at four areas in front of their business and two areas across the street.; and

WHEREAS, staff met with the business owners on Vendels Circle and worked out changes to existing parking restrictions, traffic controls, and addition of new parking restrictions agreeable to all; and

WHEREAS, The Streets and Utilities Committee reviewed the changes at their meeting of October 22, 2004 and voted 2-0 to recommend approval of the changes as presented.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles does hereby approve the following traffic control and parking restriction changes:

- Addition of 48 feet of red curb in front of Firestone Walker Brewery
- Addition of 45 feet of red curb in front of Nu-way Cleaners
- Removal of approximately 22 feet of red curb north of the Vendels/North Ramada intersection and removal of approximately 22 feet of red curb south of the Vendels/North Ramada intersection.
- Relocate traffic controls (Stop sign and stop bar) on westbound Vendels Drive at the Intersection of North Ramada further west.

SECTION 2. The City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles does hereby direct staff to implement the above changes.

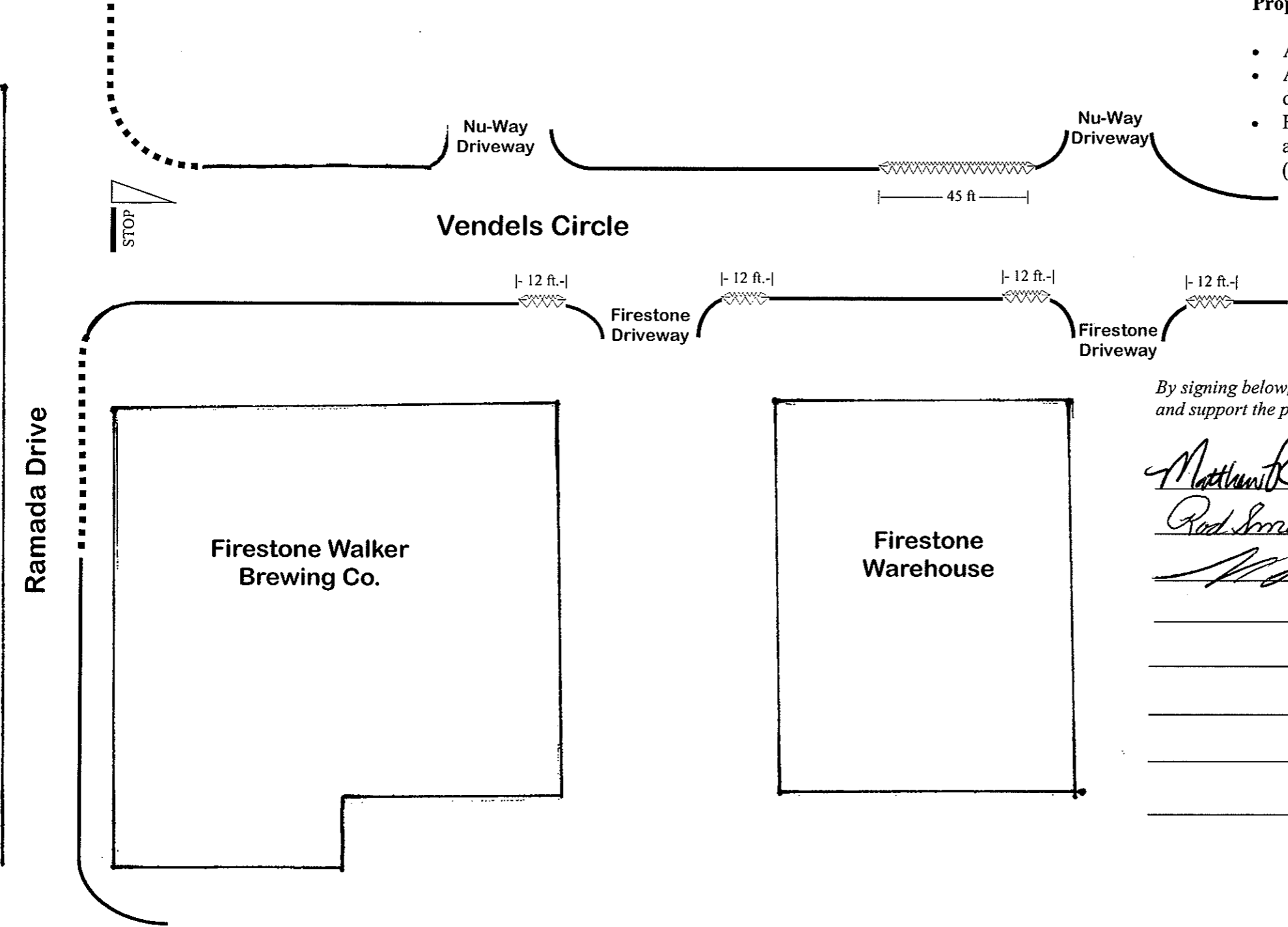
