SUBJECT: Diagonal Parking at 18th & Oak Street
DATE: September 7, 2004

NEEDS: For the City Council to consider approving diagonal parking in front of the Christian Life Center property located at the corner of 18th and Oak Streets.

- FACTS:**
1. On June 16, 2004, the City received a request from Donald W. Smith, Pastor of Christian Life Center, to replace parallel parking spaces with diagonal parking spaces in front of the Church property.
 2. This area is outside the downtown diagonal parking study area; however, the streets in question (18th and Oak) do have the appropriate width for diagonal parking on one side of the street.
 3. The Streets and Utilities Committee considered this request at their meeting of August 27, 2004, and voted 2-0 to recommend approval to the City Council.

**ANALYSIS
AND**

CONCLUSION: The Christian Life Center is a hub of activity for its members. Parking is often at a premium, especially during Sunday services. Pastor Smith wishes to help alleviate some of the inconvenience caused by the large numbers of cars by changing from parallel parking to diagonal, which, if approved and installed, will result in a net increase of 10 spaces in front of the church (12 parallel to 22 diagonal).

FISCAL

IMPACT: Site has existing curb and gutter and no road markings making installation simply a matter of painting lines. Painting will be less than \$100 and done by maintenance crews.

- OPTIONS:**
- a. Adopt Resolution No. 04-xx approving the installation of diagonal parking spaces on 18th Street and Oak Street fronting the Christian Life Center, which will result in a net increase of 10 parking spaces.
 - b. Amend, modify, or reject the above option.

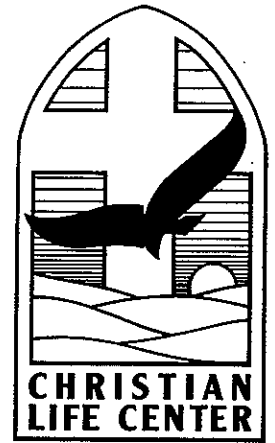



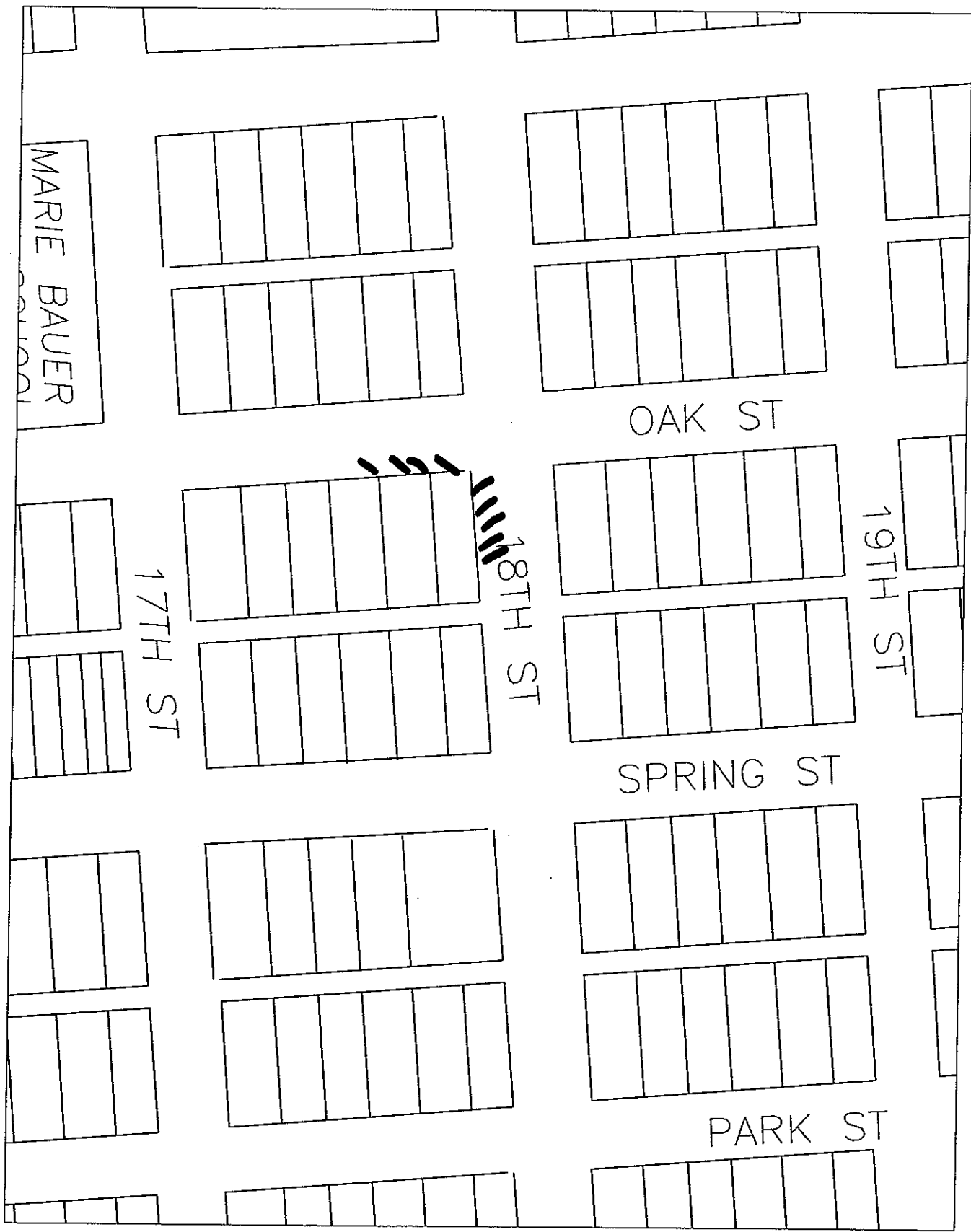
