Needs: For the City Council to consider adoption of a resolution declaring certain City property as surplus and authorize its disposal.

Facts:

1. The Police Department is in the process of replacing its supply of Department issued pistols.
2. The replaced pistols are Berreta Model 92 .40 caliber and Smith & Wesson Model 686 .38 caliber weapons that are no longer servicable for City operations.
3. These pistols will be disposed of in accordance with past practice, sell to employees at fair market value and trade the remainder to the supplier of the new weapons at fair market value.
4. Disposal of said equipment can not take place until formally declared surplus by the Council.
5. Proceeds from the sale of the surplus equipment will be recorded as revenue but will indirectly offset the cost of the new weapons

Analysis & Conclusion:

The pistols identified in the attached Exhibit "A" are no longer being used by the City. Equipment declared surplus will be first offered for sale to City employees at fair market value and the remainder will be traded to the supplier of the new weapons at fair market value.

Fiscal

Impact: Sale proceeds will be deposited back into the appropriate fund.

Options:

- a. Adopt Resolution No. 07-xxx declaring certain City property as surplus and authorize their disposal by sale or trade.
- b. Amend, modify, or reject the above option.

RESOLUTION NO. 07-XXX

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES  
DECLARING CERTAIN CITY PROPERTY AS SURPLUS

WHEREAS, the City will be purchasing new pistols to be issued as standard Police Department service weapons per Council authorization; and

WHEREAS, the City no longer has a need or use for the Police Department's current supply of Beretta Model 92 .40 pistols and Smith & Wesson Model 686 .38 revolvers; and

WHEREAS, it is highly desirable to sell the surplus equipment for the highest return possible.

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles that the City property identified in the attached Exhibit "A" are declared surplus and are to be sold first to City staff at fair market value, and the remainder will be traded to an authorized firearms dealer at fair market value; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles that the Chief of Police is authorized to undertake any and all actions to transfer title to any successful purchaser.
