WHEREAS, the City of Paso Robles will join with PG&E to educate our customers and employees about making conscious decisions to reduce energy use in their everyday lives, and


WHEREAS, the City of Paso Robles and PG&E partner to encourage property owners to build more energy efficient structures by supporting green building,
