DISCUSSION

30.1 Use of California Conservation Corps

Consider entering an agreement with the California Conservation Corps (CCC) for flood control clearing services. (On July 16, 2002, Council approved a plan to hire the CCC to provide flood control clearing services in the Salinas Riverbed. Council's action specified allocating \$60,000 for work in Phase I.)

OPTIONS:

a. Adopt Resolution No. 02-xx:

- (1) Finding an exception to the City Purchase Policy that, due to the urgent need for seasonal flood control mitigation, it's in the City's best interest to hire the California Conservation Corps to clear vegetative matter in the Salinas River;
- (2) Authorizing the Mayor to execute the Agreement with the California Conservation Corps for clearing vegetation for flood control mitigation in the Salinas River, not to exceed \$60,000; and
- (3) Directing staff to present the City Council with a revision to the City Purchase Policy to provide the means for streamlining contract procedures with other government agencies for project services.

b. Amend, modify or reject the above option.
