1. **2008 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program**

For the City Council to conduct a noticed public hearing and decide which activities are to be approved for funding with the City's 2008 Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") funds. It is expected that the City will have \$299,169 in CDBG funds available for activities in 2008—\$240,169 will be available for projects and programs, and \$59,000 would be used for program administration.
