**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES  
ADOPTING A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR THE PASO ROBLES  
(NACIMIENTO) WATER TREATMENT PLANT AND MAIN EAST PIPELINE**

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WHEREAS, pursuant to the 2003 General Plan and the 2005 Urban Water Management Plan, the City of El Paso de Robles (the "City") has initiated the work described below (the "Project") to consist of the following components:

- a. Construct a plant to treat water from the Nacimiento Water Project, up to 12 million gallons per day, store treated water, and
- b. Construct a pipeline to convey treated water to the East Side of the City.

WHEREAS, the treatment plant will be situated at the City's Thunderbird Well Site located east of Ramada Drive and the Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR), west of the Salinas River and north of an imaginary extension of Highway 46 West east of Ramada Drive and the Main East Pipeline will extend north from the proposed treatment plant, along the east side of the UPRR, to a point due west of the western terminus of the existing right-of-way for a westward extension of Charolais Road; at that point, the pipeline will turn due east, run beneath the Salinas River and through the existing right-of-way for a westward extension of Charolais Road to connect with existing water mains in South River Road; and

WHEREAS, an Initial Study was prepared for this project, and is contained within the Draft Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration for the Paso Robles Water Treatment Plant and Main East Pipeline Project, dated August 15, 2008, which shall be Exhibit "A" to this resolution, a copy of which shall be kept in the files of the Public Works Department; and

WHEREAS, the Initial Study identifies several impacts as having the potential for significant impacts as a result of this project, all of which can be mitigated by the mitigation measures listed in the Mitigation Monitoring Plan attached as Exhibit "B" to this resolution; and

WHEREAS, Public Notice of the proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration was given as required by Section 21092 of the Public Resources Code; and pursuant to said public notice, the public was given the opportunity to submit written comments and to appear before the City Council at public meetings conducted on October 7, 2008, December 16, 2008, and January 20, 2009, to make oral comments on the draft Mitigated Negative Declaration; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1.** Based on the information contained in the plans and specifications prepared for the Project on file with the City's Department of Public Works, the Initial Study prepared for the Project, public comments and testimony received during the comment period and at the public meeting conducted on October 2, 2007, and subject to completion of the mitigation measures described in both Exhibits "A" and "B", the City Council finds, based on its independent judgment and analysis, that there is no substantial evidence that the Project will have a significant effect on the environment.

SECTION 2. The mitigation measures and monitoring program identified in Exhibits A and B are hereby approved and adopted. The mitigation and monitoring measures shall be incorporated into the Project contract documents. City staff shall monitor compliance with the mitigation measures and may utilize environmental consultants to assist in monitoring Project construction to ensure compliance.

SECTION 3. The City Council of the City of Paso Robles does hereby approve and adopt the Mitigated Negative Declaration for the Project. All of the documents and other evidence which constitute the record of proceedings upon which the findings in this Resolution are made are in the custody of the Department of Public Works, City Hall, 1000 Spring Street, Paso Robles, California 93446.

SECTION 4. The City Council of the City of Paso Robles does hereby approve the Project, and directs the City Clerk to file a Notice of Determination regarding the approval of the Project with the County Clerk of San Luis Obispo County for posting.
