

RESOLUTION NO. RA 92-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY
OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES
AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURE OF \$12,000 IN SUPPORT
OF THE CITY COUNCIL'S COMMITMENT FOR THE LOCAL FUNDING MATCH
FOR REQUESTED FY 1992/93 TRANSIT CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUNDS

WHEREAS, the City of El Paso de Robles contributed \$3,000 to fund a Rail Improvement Feasibility Study that included a multimodal rail station location assessment for the City; and

WHEREAS, "ALL ABOARD NORTH COUNTY", a Paso Robles based non-profit rail advocacy group has gathered over 3,000 signatures in support of a rail stop in the City of El Paso de Robles; and

WHEREAS, the City of El Paso de Robles has dedicated staff time to apply for funding a multimodal facility feasibility and preliminary engineering study under the Transit Capital Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, promoting multimodal transportation opportunities is a priority in the adopted 1990 Regional Transportation Plan prepared by the San Luis Obispo Area Coordinating Council; and

WHEREAS, the Rail Improvement Feasibility Study has determined that the revenue and patronage of a passenger rail station in El Paso de Robles would be favorable; and

WHEREAS, completed alternatives, environmental and preliminary engineering studies will greatly enhance competitiveness for funding under Proposition 116; and

WHEREAS, the Transit Capital Improvement Program requires a local match of funds 50% of the total project cost.

WHEREAS, the Transit Improvement is consistent with the objectives of the Redevelopment Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has committed to funding in the amount of \$15,500 and has requested that the Agency commit \$12,000 as its share of the \$27,000 project costs,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Redevelopment Agency of the City of El Paso de Robles hereby authorizes expenditure of \$12,000 from Redevelopment Agency Professional Services account to assist the City Council in funding the required local match of the 92/93 Transit Improvement Grant.
