

RESOLUTION NO. RA 92-03

A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY
OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES
APPROPRIATING \$15,000 TO IMPLEMENT THE
RE-ORGANIZED 1992 GRAFFITI REMOVAL PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City Council in 1987-88 evidenced increasing concern over the presence of graffiti in the community and therefore instituted a decentralized program of graffiti removal to address the problem; and

WHEREAS, the decentralized graffiti removal program remained an effective corrective measure until approximately 1991 when, given the existing nuisance abatement procedures and lack of resources, the amount of graffiti began to accumulate; and

WHEREAS, graffiti remains a problem throughout North County and in Paso Robles; and

WHEREAS, the presence of graffiti misrepresents the community's commitment to fighting the diseases that graffiti come to symbolize; and

WHEREAS, graffiti can affect a City's ability to attract new businesses or retain existing businesses in the area; and

WHEREAS, graffiti is a community-wide challenge and concern; and

WHEREAS, re-organization of the graffiti program would provide an effective means of combating graffiti as it exists today; and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency and the City Council seek to foster a cooperative alliance with members of the community who are concerned over, and wish to undertake efforts to achieve, a safer community; and

WHEREAS, community volunteers can play an integral role in the control and abatement of graffiti;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Redevelopment Agency of the City of El Paso de Robles that appropriation of \$15,000 is authorized to assist in the implementation of the re-organized 1992 Graffiti Removal Program.
