

RESOLUTION NO. RA 95-06

A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY
OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES
ESTABLISHING AN APPROPRIATIONS LIMIT
FOR THE DISASTER ASSISTANCE LOAN PROGRAM
FOR DAMAGES DUE TO THE MARCH, 1995 RAINS

WHEREAS, at its meeting of June 6, 1995, the Redevelopment Agency of the City of El Paso de Robles adopted Resolution RA 95-04 establishing a Disaster Assistance Program to assist low and moderate income owners of homes damaged by natural disasters by providing loans not exceeding \$10,000 per dwelling from the Redevelopment Low and Moderate Income housing Fund; and

WHEREAS, Item #6 of Exhibit A of Resolution RA 95-04 specifies that funds will not be made available in any fiscal year until a federal or state disaster area has been declared and until the Redevelopment Agency/City Council adopts a resolution setting forth the amount of funds to be available and the time period for submitting applications; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the March, 1995 rains, San Luis Obispo County was declared a federal disaster area and the City is aware of only three homes that might meet the eligibility criteria established in Item #4 of Resolution RA 95-04;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of the City of El Paso de Robles to establish a funding limit of \$30,000 from the Disaster Assistance Loan Program for Fiscal Year 1995/96 for loans to qualifying victims of the March, 1995 rains and a sixty (60) day period, beginning August 15, 1995, in which to file applications for said assistance.
