

RESOLUTION NO. RA 01-03

A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES
APPROVING A PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT AND AFFORDABILITY COVENANT IN
CONJUNCTION WITH A GRANT OF REDEVELOPMENT LOW AND MODERATE INCOME HOUSING
FUNDS TO ASSIST THE DEVELOPMENT OF AFFORDABLE SENIOR HOUSING BY PEOPLES' SELF-
HELP HOUSING CORP. AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR SAID GRANT
(CREEKSIDE GARDENS)

WHEREAS, Peoples' Self-Help Housing Corp. ("PSHHC"), a nonprofit organization that develops housing for low income households, has requested that the Paso Robles Redevelopment Agency ("Agency") provide a grant of up to \$435,000 in Low and Moderate Income Housing ("LMIH") Funds to assist in the development of 29 housing units for occupancy by very low income seniors, to be located on a 7acre property located on the north side of Oak Hill Road, west of Nicklaus Drive ("the Project"); and

WHEREAS, PSHHC has informed the Agency that it has received a \$2.3 million Federal HUD Section 202 Capital Grant to build senior housing in North County, which PSHHC plans to use for development of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Project would help the City meet its low-income housing needs, as set forth in the 1994 Housing Element of the General Plan; this project also conforms with Housing Element Policy 1.6, which calls for dispersal of low income housing, rather than concentrating it in a few neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, the Project would further the Agency's goals and objectives set forth in the Redevelopment Plan for the Paso Robles Redevelopment Project and the 1999 Redevelopment Implementation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the 1999 Redevelopment Implementation Plan provides that the Agency may consider requests to use LMIH funds to assist large-scale multi-family projects (those with more than 12 dwelling units), following a recommendation by the Project Area Committee; and

WHEREAS, California Community Redevelopment Law (Health and Safety Code Sections 33000 et seq.) provides that the Agency may enter into Participation Agreements and may provide financial assistance for development of affordable housing opportunities within the community; and

WHEREAS, Community Redevelopment Law (Health and Safety Code Section 33334.3[f]) requires that any rental housing units assisted with LMIH funds shall remain available at affordable housing costs to persons and families of low and moderate income and lower income households for the longest feasible time, but not less than fifteen (15) years; and

WHEREAS, at a meeting conducted on January 31, 2001, the Project Area Committee considered PSHHC's request and recommended that the Agency approve the requested assistance in the form of a grant;

WHEREAS, the Agency and PSCCH have cooperated in the preparation of a Participation Agreement which set forth the terms and conditions relating to the LMIH Grant, including without limitation an Affordable Housing Covenant (the "Affordability Covenant") to be executed by the parties and recorded against the Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Paso Robles Redevelopment Agency as follows:

SECTION 1: The Agency hereby approves the Participation Agreement, including without limitation the Affordability Covenant incorporated therein as Exhibit F, with Peoples' Self-Help Housing Corp., in substantially the form attached to this resolution as Exhibit A, subject to any technical and non-substantive changes approved by Agency Counsel. The Agency's Executive Director and Secretary are authorized and directed to execute the Participation Agreement on behalf of the Agency, and subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the Participation Agreement, to take all acts and execute such additional documents as may be necessary to carry out the Agency's obligations under the Participation Agreement, including without limitation execution and recordation of the Affordability Covenant and appropriation and disbursement of the LMIH Grant provided for under the Participation Agreement.

SECTION 2: The Agency hereby authorizes the appropriation of \$435,000 from the Agency's Low and Moderate Income Housing funds to Account No. 701-810-5235-485 to assist the development of the Project.
