

RESOLUTION NO. 54.

Adopted February 15, 1926.

WHEREAS, a general municipal election will be held in the City of El Paso de Robles, on Monday, the 12th day of April, 1926, for the election of two trustees, each for the full term of four years; therefore,

BE IT, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, That for the purposes of holding said election there shall be but one precinct to be known and designated as Consolidated Voting Precinct A, and which shall consist of a consolidation of the regular election precincts established for holding State and County elections, known as Paso Robles No.1, Paso Robles No.2, and Paso Robles No.3; that the voting place shall be at the place of meeting of the Board of Trustees of said City, in the City Hall at 723 Thirteenth Street, in said City of El Paso de Robles; that the polls will be open between the hours of 7 o'clock A.M., and 7 o'clock P.M.

BE IT, AND IT IS HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the election officers to conduct the general municipal election to be held in the City of El Paso de Robles, on Monday, the 12th day of April, 1926, be, and they are hereby appointed and designated as follows:

For Consolidated Precinct A:

Clerks (2) Juanita Anderson and Jennie Thompson

That the compensation of each election officer is hereby fixed at \$5.00 for his services in said election.
