

RESOLUTION No.57.

Adopted April 5, 1926.

WHEREAS, certain parties directly interested therein are endeavoring to secure a completion of the State Highway running along the extreme Coast between Carmel and San Simeon; and

WHEREAS, the last thirteen miles on the Carmel end of said highway, under what is known as the Pollack Contract, cost in excess of \$60,000.00 a mile, and the grading alone of the last thirteen miles next to San Simeon, under the Blake and Henery Contract, cost in excess of \$24,000.00 per mile; and

WHEREAS, said highway will not be nearly as much used as are some of the other unpaved highways of our State and would subserve the interest of tourists and pleasure seekers rather than the business interests of the State, and the cost of constructing the same per mile, will be far in excess of the cost of constructing any one of many other highways which should be paved as soon as possible.

BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED: That the Board of Trustees of City of El Paso de Robles do hereby petition His Excellency, Friend W. Richardson, Governor of the State of California, Honorable Harvey M. Toy, Chairman, and Messrs. Everding and Edwards of the State Highway Commission, to defer further work on said Carmel-San Simeon Highway until other routes of travel which would be much more frequently used than said Carmel-San Simeon road, have been properly graded and paved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Honorable Friend W. Richardson, Harvey M. Toy, President of the State Highway Commission, and Robert M. Morton, State Engineering Department, as being the sense of this Board, and declaring the completion of this road at this time as undesirable, by reason of the excessive costs thereof, and demand for the expenditure of the highway funds on arteries more subject to traffic.
