

RESOLUTION NO.58.

Adopted April 19th. 1926.

RESOLUTION DECLARING RESULT OF THE REGULAR MUNICIPAL
ELECTION HELD APRIL 12,1926.

WHEREAS, a general municipal election was held in the City of El Paso de Robles, California, on Monday the 12th day of April, 1926, for the purpose of electing two members of the Board of Trustees of said City for four years; and

WHEREAS, it appears that said election was held and conducted in accordance with the election laws of the State of California applicable to cities of the sixth class, and that the Board of Trustees of said City gave notice of said election, as required bylaw, and established one election precinct designated as Consolidated Precinct A consisting of the regular State and County election precincts known as Paso Robles No.1, Paso Robles No.2, and Paso Robles No.3, for the purpose of said election, and appointed a board of election therefor, and fixed the compensation of the members thereof, and fixed the polling place for precinct; that said was held and conducted, and the votes cast thereat were received and canvassed and returns thereon made in time, form and manner as required by law; and

WHEREAS, said Board of Trustees did meet on this 19th day of April, 1926, being the first Monday succeeding said election, for the purpose of canvassing the vote cast thereat, and did thereupon canvass the same, whereupon it was found that the vote cast at said election was as follows:

For Ellsworth Harrold, for trustee, 56 votes
For James G.Hibbard, for trustee, 53 votes
For Walter I.Brush, for trustee, 1 vote
For Burt Davis, for trustee, 2 votes

That the total number of votes cast at said election was fifty-seven; and

WHEREAS, it appears from the canvass of the votes cast at said election that the persons next hereafter named received a majority of all vote cast thereat for the respective offices mentioned.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved, determined and declared by the Board of Trustees of the City of El Paso de Robles that at the general municipal election held in said City on Monday, the 12th day of April, 1926, the persons elected to the respective offices for the term stated and until their successors are duly elected and qualified are as follows:

Ellsworth Harrold, as trustee, for four years.

James G.Hibbard, as trustee, for four years.
