

RESOLUTION NO.65.

Adopted October 18, 1926.

BE IT, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, THAT;

WHEREAS, under date of January 20, 1926, this City entered into a contract with J.F. Shepardon for the construction of a reservoir and pipe line in said City, which work was undertaken and partly performed under said contract by said J.F. Shepardon; and

WHEREAS, said J.F. Shepardon is required by law to file a bond for the faithful performance of said work with the Southern Surety Company as surety thereon; and

WHEREAS, said work has not been completed though the time granted by said City for completion thereof has long since expired; and

WHEREAS, said J.F. Shepardon, has abandoned said work and shows no apparent intention of completing the same;

THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that unless said work is completed on or before the 31st. day of October, 1926, that said City of El Paso de Robles shall take charge of said work and complete the same and deduct the costs thereof from the moneys agreed to be paid in said contract to said J.F. Shepardon still remaining on hand and not received by him.
