RESOLUTION NO. 102.

Adopted October 1, 1928.

WHEREAS, On April 19, 1920, the Board of Trustees of the City of El Paso de Robles, by Ordinance duly passed, granted to the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Luis Obispo permission to use Spring Street from the Southerly end thereof to the Southerly line of Ninth Street; and from the Northerly end of Spring Street to the Northerly line of Twentieth Street for the purpose of constructing and maintaining thereon by said Board of Supervisors a highway as a part of the State or County system of roads within the City limits of this City, and

WHEREAS, the said Board of Supervisors did on the first day of October, 1928, adopt a resolution by the affirmative vote of all of its members, declaring said above described portions of Spring Street to be no longer a part of the County system of highways;

THEREFORE, BE IT, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the City of El Paso de Robles does hereby resume control of said portions of Spring Street and said permission so granted to said Board of Supervisors on
