

RESOLUTION No. 124-A

Adopted 14th day of August 1929

Board of Equalization
corrections

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees, known as the City Council in and for the City of El Paso de Robles, County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, did on the 12th day of August 1929, at 10 o'clock in the forenoon of said day, commence to sit as a Board of Equalization as provided by law; and

WHEREAS, said Board of Equalization has regularly continued in session from day to day to this day; and

WHEREAS, at said time certain complaints were made before, and on file with, said City Council, sitting as a Board of Equalization, by tax payers in and for the City of El Paso de Robles, County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, and affecting assessments on property owned by said tax payers; and

WHEREAS, said Board of Trustees known as the City Council, sitting as a Board of Equalization, has duly heard said complaints and received testimony from said complainants relative thereto.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the assessment of the Arlington Hotel Company be corrected and altered to read as follows:
