

RESOLUTION # 166

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, that the location of the polling place and the names of the election officers and compensation provided for them in the election to be held April 11, 1932, be, and the same are hereby fixed as follows:

There shall be one election precinct to be known as Consolidated Voting Precinct A, which shall consist of all the regular election precincts, Paso Robles, No. 1, Paso Robles No. 2, Paso Robles No. 3, Paso Robles No 4, and Paso Robles No. 5.

That the polling place shall be at the City Hall, 723 - 13th Street, in the City of El Paso de Robles, and the following are hereby named and appointed as election officers to conduct said election.

 Clerks Irene B. McConnell and Maude Terris


That each of said election officers be paid the sum of \$7.00 as full compensation for his services for conducting said election.
