

RESOLUTION OVERRULING PROTEST TO CUTTING OF WEEDS.

# 169

WHEREAS, this City Council did on the 21st day of March, 1932, duly pass and adopt a resolution declaring certain weeds of a dangerous and noxious character growing upon and in front of the property on Ninth Street, Tenth Street, Eleventh Street, twelfth Street, Thirteenth Street, Fourteenth Street, Fifteenth Street, Sixteenth Street, Seventh Street, Eighteenth Street, Nineteenth Street, Twentieth Street, Pine Street, Park Street, Spring Street, Oak Street, Vine Street, and Olive Street. in the City of El Paso de Robles, to be nuisances; reference being hereby made to said resolution for a more particular description of said property; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said resolution, the Supt. of Streets of this City did post notices on the property, on or in front of which said weeds are growing, giving notice of the passage of said resolution, and requiring all property owners having any objections to propose against the removal of said weeds, to appear before the Board on the 4th day of April, 1932, at eight o'clock P.M., when their objections would be heard; and

WHEREAS, no one appeared at said time or place, or otherwise and made any such objection, and no such objection was

made;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND DECLARED that there is no objection to the cutting of said weeds, and the Superintendent of Streets is hereby directed to remove said weeds, as required by law.
