Adopted Dec 3 1934

BE IT, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED:

That Leo Chury be, and he is hereby appointed an officer of the City of El Paso de Robles, his term to begin with the 1 day of January, 1935, and to hold office at the pleasure of the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, and to receive a salary of \$100.00 per month, payable monthly on the first day of each month for services rendered in the previous calendar month; that said officer shall give a bond to the City of El Paso de Robles executed by a Surety Company authorized to do business in the State of California, in the penal sum of \$5,000 and subject to the approval of the City Council, which bond shall be conditioned to cover the faithful performance by said officer of the duties of his office, and of his duties with respect to all moneys coming into his hands as such officer under this resolution and under the ordinances of said City and under any law of the State of California.

BE IT, AND IT IS HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED that said officer shall be known as "City Tax and License Collector" and his duties shall be to collect and pay to the City Treasurer daily as collected, all taxes and license fees of said City, and perform such other duties as may be required of him by the City Council, and he shall file with the City Clerk a detailed statement at least once each month of all moneys handled by him in his official capacity during the preceding month. That he take duplicate receipts from the Treasurer for all money paid to him, retaining one in his files and delivering the other to the City Clerk.
