

RESOLUTION # 223

February 17th 1936

Resolution establishing polling place, appointing election officers and fixing their compensation.

BE IT, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Council of the City of El Paso de Robles that the location of the polling place and the names of the election officers and compensation for their services in the City Election to be held on April 14, 1936, be and the same are hereby fixed as follows:

There shall be one election precinct to be known as Consolidated Voting Precinct A, which shall consist of the regular election precincts Paso Robles No. 1, Paso Robles No.2, Paso Robles No.3, Paso Robles No. 4, and Paso Robles No. 5.

The polling place shall be at the City Hall at 723 Thirteenth Street.

The following election officers are hereby appointed to conduct said election:

Two Clerks	<u>Mrs. Wm. P. Miles</u>

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that each of said election officers be paid the sum of \$ 10.00 as full compensation for his services in conducting said election.

That the polls shall be open at 7 o'clock A.M. of said day and be kept open until 6 O'clock P.M. thereof when the polls shall be closed.
