
RESOLUTION #231

BE IT RESOLVED, THAT, WHEREAS, the City of El Paso de Robles did on the 16th day of March, 1936, pass a resolution declaring certain weeds growing within said City to be a public nuisance, which resolution referred to the streets by the names under which they are comonly known, and described the property upon which or in front of which, said nuisance exists, by giving the lot and block number of the same according to the official map of said City and directed that the Street Superintendent post in front of said property notices as by law required; and

WHEREAS, it appearing that the Street Superintendent has so posted said notices and that in said notice said Street Superintendent fixed the 6th day of April, 1936, at the hour of 8o'clock P.M. as the time for hearing objections or protests to the cutting of said weeds; and

WHEREAS, no protests or objections having been made to the cutting of said weeds, the City Council now has jurisdiction to order the removal thereof; and

BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Street Superintendent abate said nuisance by having the weeds referred to removed, provided that any property owner shall have the right to have any such weeds removed at his own expense, provided that same is done prior to the arrival of the Street Superintendent or his representative, to do the same.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Street Superintendent keep an account of the cost of abating such nuisance in front of or on each seperate lot or parcel of land where work has been done by him or his deputies, and render an itemized report in writing to the City Council as required by law.
