RESOLUTION CONFIRMING REPORT OF CITY STREET SUPERINTENDENT AS TO  
COST OF CUTTING WEEDS, ETC.

WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees of the City of El Paso de Robles, did on the 16th day of March, 1936, pass a resolution declaring the weeds and grass on certain streets in said resolution particularly described, to be a public nuisance, and


WHEREAS, after the passage of said resolution, the Street Superintendent caused to be conspicuously posted in front of the property in front of which the said nuisance existed, and at not more than one hundred feet in distance in distance apart, but not less than three in all, notices headed "Notice to Destroy Weeds", such heading being in words not less than one inch in height, which notice was in the form required by section 3, of an act entitled: "An Act Authorizing Municipalities To Declare Noxious or Dangerous Weeds Growing Upon The Streets Or Sidewalks, Or Upon Private Property Within Municipalities, To Be A Public Nuisance, To Create A Lien Upon the Property Fronting Upon Such Streets Or Sidewalks Or Upon Which Such Nuisance Exists For The Costs Of Abating The Same", approved May 26th, 1915, and

WHEREAS, at the times stated in the said notices the City Board of Trustees did hear and determine and consider all objections and protests to the removal of weeds, and by resolution overruled any and all objections and directed the Street Superintendent to abate said nuisance by having the said weeds removed; and

WHEREAS, said Street Superintendent has removed said weeds and rendered an itemized report in writing to this Board of Trustees showing the cost of removing such weeds in front of each separate lot, and posted a copy of said report for three days prior to this date near the chamber door of this Board of Trustees, together with the notice of the time when said report should be submitted to this board for confirmation, and no objections having been raised to said report or assessments, and the Board of Trustees having received, examined and considered said report at this time (which is the time affixed in the said notice for the submission of said report) and which report is attached hereto and made a part hereof; it is hereby

RESOLVED: That said report be and the same is hereby approved and confirmed, and the amounts of the cost of abating such nuisance in front of or upon the various parcels of land described in said report shall constitute special assessments against the respective parcels of land and as thus made and confirmed shall constitute liens upon said property for the amounts of such assessments, respectively.

The foregoing resolution is hereby approved after adoption this 22nd day of June, 1936.
