

RESOLUTION NO. 373

OPPOSING THE TRANSFER INTO THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES OF ANY ON-SALE DISTILLED SPIRITS LICENSES.

WHEREAS, the City of El Paso de Robles is a city with a population of 3033, according to the latest census figures.

AND WHEREAS, many problems affecting the public peace, health and safety will arise within said city due to the construction within the County of San Luis Obispo of several army camps, one of which is to be located close to said city and which camp will house some 20,000 or more men undergoing training in the National Defense program.

AND WHEREAS, the Board of Equalization of the State of California did heretofore adopt a rule prohibiting the issuance of any new on-sale distilled spirits licenses in any city or county during the time when there were already issued and in effect therein at least one such license for each 1000 of population.

AND WHEREAS, there are now issued and in effect in the City of El Paso de Robles twenty-two (22) on-sale distilled spirits licenses, including numerous on-sale beer and wine licenses; and such number of on-sale licenses makes one such license in said city for each 138 of population.

AND WHEREAS, no rule has been adopted by the State Board of Equalization prohibiting the transfer into said city of any on-sale distilled spirits license previously issued at some location outside of said city, but within the County of San Luis Obispo, which fact operates to nullify the rule prohibiting the issuance of new licenses where there already exists one license for each 138 population.

AND WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles is opposed to an increase in the number of on-sale distilled spirits licenses within said city.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles that it does hereby oppose the transfer into said city of any on-sale distilled spirits licenses and does hereby recommend to the State Board of Equalization that any application made for any such transfer be denied.




