

## RESOLUTION NO. 398

WHEREAS: the United States of America has heretofore filed application No. 10211, for certain unappropriated and surplus water of the Salinas River, for the use at Camp San Luis Obispo, more particularly described in said application; and

WHEREAS, the City of El Paso de Robles did, pursuant to a resolution adopted at a regular meeting of the Council of that City on July 7, 1941, file a protest against the approval of said application of the United States of America; and


WHEREAS, the Zone Construction Quartermaster, Zone 1X, San Francisco, California, has requested the City of withdraw its said protest to said application of the United States of America, in order to facilitate the construction of this Defense Project; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of said City as expressed through its duly constituted officials, to cooperate with, and render all assistance possible to, the United States of America in carrying out its activities and projects under the Defense Program:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of said City of El Paso de Robles, in regular meeting held this 18th day of August, 1941, that said protest against the United States of America be withdrawn and a copy of this resolution attested by the Mayor and Clerk, be furnished the United States of America and a copy mailed to the Division of Water Resources of the State of California, at Sacramento, California.
