

RESOLUTION NO. 1008

A RESOLUTION OVERRULING PROTESTS ON RESOLUTION  
OF INTENTION NO. 997

23rd STREET, ET AL  
PROJECT NO. 57-1

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Paso Robles,  
California, that

WHEREAS, this Council did on February 18, 1957, adopt its  
Resolution of Intention No. 997 to construct public improvements  
in and for said City;

WHEREAS, on April 15, 1957, this Council adopted a resolution  
appointing time and place of hearing protests in relation to the  
proposed improvements and directing notice;

WHEREAS, notice was given of the time and place therein stated  
in the manner provided by law, as appears from the affidavits on  
file in the office of the City Clerk;

WHEREAS, said matter came on regularly for hearing at the  
time therein fixed; and

WHEREAS, all written protests and other written communications  
were publicly read at said meeting and all persons desiring to be  
heard were fully heard;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, as follows:

1. That protests against said improvements were not signed  
by the owners of a majority or more of the area of the lands with-  
in the assessment district, or of the area of the lands within the  
assessment district assessed for the costs and expenses of said work.
2. That said protests be, and each of them are hereby, over-  
ruled.


