

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL TO
PASS A SALES TAX ORDINANCE PURSUANT TO THE PRO-
VISIONS OF THE UNIFORM SALES TAX ACT

WHEREAS, the City of El Paso de Robles many years last past has had a local Sales and Use Tax Ordinance at the rate of one (1%) per cent on retail sales, pursuant to the State Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the sales tax is a fair and just tax which partially relieves the burden of the general property tax; and

WHEREAS, it is to the interest of the City of El Paso de Robles and of the County of San Luis Obispo to have a uniform sales tax throughout the County and to provide for the uniform collection thereof by an agency of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, it is proper that a portion of the sales tax levied on retail sales within this City be allocated to the County of San Luis Obispo;

BE, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the City Council of El Paso de Robles declares its intention to enter into a uniform County wide sales tax; and


RESOLVED FURTHER that the sum of ten (10%) per cent of the gross sales tax collected in this City be allocated to the general fund of the County of San Luis Obispo to be used for relief of the general property tax payers throughout the County;

RESOLVED FURTHER that this City Council will by ordinance pass a sales tax law under the provision of the uniform sales tax act to provide for such allocation on condition that the County of San Luis Obispo likewise passes a uniform

sales tax ordinance.
