

RESOLUTION NO. 1028

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING PREVAILING WAGE SCALE

TRACT 95 - SEVENTEENTH STREET
PROJECT NO. 56-1

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Paso Robles, California, that

WHEREAS, the City Council of said City has ascertained the general prevailing rate of per diem wages in the locality in which public work is proposed to be performed for work of a similar character to that described in Resolution of Intention No. 963, adopted August 20, 1956, and Resolution of Intention to Make Changes and Modifications adopted September 3, 1957;

WHEREAS, said rate of per diem wages is set forth and contained in the specifications for said project, copies of which are on file in the office of the City Engineer and also in the office of the City Clerk of said City; and

WHEREAS, this Council has duly considered said scale and finds the same to be correct in all particulars;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY FOUND, DETERMINED and ORDERED, as follows:

1. That said wage scale as set forth in said specifications is hereby established and adopted as the prevailing rate of per diem wages for work of a similar character to that above described in the locality in which such public work is proposed to be performed.

2. That not less than said prevailing rate of per diem wages shall be paid for any work proposed to be performed under said Resolution of Intention and Resolution of Intention to Make Changes and Modifications.


