

RESOLUTION - NO. 1035

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR GUIDANCE OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION IN INTERPRETING THE OFF STREET PARKING ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS Section 1, of Ordinance No. 207 N.S. of this City provides that, among other powers, the Planning Commission may require one (1) parking space for each six (6) seats for all places of public assembly to be constructed, altered, or enlarged after the effective date of said Ordinance No. 207 N.S.; and

WHEREAS this City and its residents have enjoyed the substantial benefits of the numerous churches now in existence in this City; and

WHEREAS the said churches are located outside of the existing business districts of this City and said churches are usually attended during non-business hours;

NOW THEREFORE BE AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES AS FOLLOWS:

1. That it is for the best interest of this City and its residents that Ordinance No. 207 N.S. be strictly enforced, in conformity with accepted principles of municipal planning;
2. That for churches in existence on the day of passage of this Resolution, which churches are substantially altered, enlarged, or rebuilt in the immediate vicinity of their existing locations, and when the approval of the Traffic Commission

of this City is made to the effect that there is no traffic hazard existing from the parking at said church, then and in that event only off street parking as provided in Ordinance No. 207 N.S. shall be required only for such additional seating capacity that arises from such material alterations, enlargements, or rebuilding of such church.

3. This Resolution shall remain in full force and effect until modified or repealed by the City Council. Further, this Resolution is passed and adopted for the guidance of the Planning Commission and of the several churches of this City.
