

RESOLUTION NO. 992

AUTHORIZING THE CANCELLATION OF  
TAXES ON STATE OWNED PROPERTIES

WHEREAS, the State of California did by deed number 13722 and recorded on November 14, 1956, in Volume 869 at page 513 of the Official Records of the County of San Luis Obispo, acquire the property hereinafter described from Frank and Lupital Berta:

All that portion of Sand Spring and Mud Bath Reservation in the City of El Paso de Robles described as follows:

Beginning at Post No. 4; thence N 34° 30'W, 299.64 feet; thence S 55° 30'W, 79.86 feet; thence N 34° 30'W to Northerly line of the City of El Paso de Robles; thence Easterly along said line to the Easterly line of the Sand Spring and Mud Bath Reservation; thence S 38° 30'E, 15 feet, more or less; thence S 55° 30'W, 852.06 feet to the point of beginning.

WHEREAS, said property was assessed on the tax rolls of the City of El Paso de Robles at the time of purchase with the taxes for the fiscal year 1956-1957 shown under Assessment No. 24 not having been paid in the amount of \$ 15.22, and

WHEREAS, said property having been acquired by the State of California for highway purposes and because of such use and public ownership is not subject to city taxes, and

WHEREAS, the State of California, acting through the Department of Public Works, Division of Highways, has petitioned the City for cancellation of said taxes as provided for under Section 4986 of the Revenue and Taxation Code of the State of California.


