

RESOLUTION NO. 995

RESOLUTION REGARDING EMERGENCY FIRE SERVICE

WHEREAS, on January 7, 1957, a petition was filed with the City Council requesting that fire protection be given under contract between this City and an immediately adjoining fire district, as soon as said district is formed, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has carefully considered the matter and also recognizes that a dangerous and unusual condition presently exists regarding unexplained fires in and near the City of El Paso de Robles, and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it is for the best interests of the residents of this City that fire protection be extended on a temporary basis, and

WHEREAS, the Forestry Service has indicated orally that it would like assistance of one piece of Paso Robles fire equipment during this emergency.


BE AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that working within the framework of the resolution establishing the policy of giving fire protection outside the city limits, this City Council will make available, upon receipt of written request from the Forestry Service, so to do, one piece of fire equipment only.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that said equipment shall be used only for fighting structural fires occurring within a limit of one-half mile within the existing city limits of this City.


RESOLVED FURTHER, that this resolution shall be in full force and effect, until revoked by the City Council, but in no event shall it be in full force and effect longer than ninety days from the date hereof.
