

RESOLUTION NO. 1087

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES CONSENTING TO THE COMMENCEMENT OF ANNEXATION PROCEEDINGS FOR THE ANNEXATION TO THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES OF CERTAIN INHABITED AND UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY IN THE COUNTY OF SAN LUIS OBISPO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, CONTIGUOUS TO THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES DESIGNATED AS "ANNEXATION NO. 8".

WHEREAS, an informal petition has heretofore been filed with the City Clerk of the City of El Paso de Robles and was presented to the City Council of this City requesting that the City Council give its consent to the commencement of annexation proceedings in connection with that certain inhabited territory contiguous to this City; and

WHEREAS, said petition was referred to the Planning Commission of the City of El Paso de Robles for investigation, report and recommendation; and

WHEREAS, said Planning Commission rendered its report and recommendation to the City Council that said annexation proceeding be commenced; and

WHEREAS, the matter has been referred to the County Boundary Commission of the County of San Luis Obispo and certain changes were made in the description at the request of said Commission; and

WHEREAS, the County Boundary Commission of San Luis Obispo County has now approved the boundaries of Annexation No. 8 as to definiteness and certainty; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Council to give its consent to the commencement of such annexation proceedings upon condition that the electors within said territory be informed at the time the petition for annexation is circulated that the question to be submitted to said electors shall be whether the territory shall be annexed and the prop-

erty in the territory subjected to taxation after annexation equally with the property within the City of El Paso de Robles to pay the entire bonded indebtedness of the City of El Paso de Robles outstanding or authorized at the date of the filing of the petition for annexation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles:

SECTION 1. That consent be and hereby is granted for the commencement of annexation proceedings in connection with said inhabited territory in accordance with the Annexation Act of 1913 provided the petition for annexation contains a request that the question to be submitted to the electors residing in the territory proposed to be annexed shall be whether the territory shall be annexed and the property in the territory subjected to taxation after annexation equally with property within the City of El Paso de Robles to pay the bonded indebtedness of the City of El Paso de Robles outstanding or authorized at the date of the filing of the petition for annexation.


SECTION 2. That said unincorporated territory be and hereby is designated as "Annexation No. 8", and consists generally of the Capital Hill area, and lands adjoining thereto, and lying Southerly of Creston Road and East of the Salinas River. Said land is more particularly described as:

All that real property situate in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, as shown on Maps of Rancho Santa Ysabel and Olive Parks filed in the office of the County Recorder of said County, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the center line of Creston Road, (County Road No. 91) said point being the northwest corner of Lot 25, Olive Park Tract, Book A, page 32 of Maps; thence S 72° 30' E along the north line of said Lot 25, 65 feet to a point; thence S 8° 35' W 30.37 feet to a point in the south line of said Creston Road, being a point in the South City Boundary of the City of El Paso de Robles, said point being the true point of beginning; thence continuing S 8° 35' W 588.28 feet to a point lying in a line parallel with said center

line of Creston Road distant 611.18 feet therefrom; thence N 72° 30' W along said parallel line 1400 feet more or less to a point in the east line of Lot 15, Rancho Santa Ysabel; thence S 8° 30' W 200.93 feet more or less to the southeast corner of said Lot 15; thence West 3,036 feet more or less along the south line of said Lot 15 to the southwest corner thereof; thence continuing West along said south line produced 160 feet more or less to a point in the west bank of the Salinas River, being the Easterly City Boundary of the City of El Paso de Robles; thence northerly and easterly along said East City Boundary to the true point of beginning.
