

RESOLUTION NO. 1096

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES DECLARING ITS INTENTION TO CALL A SPECIAL ELECTION IN CERTAIN INHABITED TERRITORY CONTIGUOUS TO SAID CITY PROPOSED TO BE ANNEXED THERETO, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS RESIDING IN SAID TERRITORY THE QUESTION WHETHER OR NOT SAID TERRITORY SHALL BE ANNEXED TO THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES, AND FIXING A TIME AND PLACE WHEN AND WHERE ANY PERSON OWNING REAL PROPERTY WITHIN SUCH TERRITORY MAY APPEAR BEFORE SAID CITY COUNCIL AND SHOW CAUSE WHY SUCH TERRITORY SHOULD NOT BE SO ANNEXED (Annexation No. 8)

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles:

SECTION 1: That it is the intention of the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles to call a special election to be held on the 12th day of May, 1959, in certain inhabited territory contiguous to said city, proposed to be annexed thereto, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors residing in said territory the question whether or not said territory shall be annexed to the City of El Paso de Robles and the property in the territory subjected to taxation after annexation equally with property within the City of El Paso de Robles to pay the bonded indebtedness of the City of El Paso de Robles outstanding or authorized at the date of the filing of the petition for annexation for the acquisition, construction or completion of municipal improvements.

Said territory is described as follows:

All that real property situate in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, as shown on Maps of Rancho Santa Ysabel and Olive

Parks filed in the office of the County Recorder of said County, more particularly described as follows:


Beginning at a point on the center line of Creston Road, (County Road No. 91) said point being the northwest corner of Lot 25, Olive Park Tract, Book A, page 32 of Maps; thence S 72° 30'E along said north line of said Lot 25, 65 feet to a point; thence S 8° 35'W 30.37 feet to a point in the south line of said Creston Road, being a point in the South City Boundary of the City of El Paso de Robles, said point being the true point of beginning; thence continuing S 8° 35'W 588.28 feet to a point lying in a line parallel with said center line of Creston Road distant 611.18 feet therefrom; thence N 72° 30'W along said parallel line 1400 feet more or less to a point in the east line of Lot 15, Rancho Santa Ysabel; thence S 8° 30'W 200.93 feet more or less to the southeast corner of said Lot 15; thence West 3,036 feet more or less along the south line of said Lot 15 to the southwest corner thereof; thence continuing West along said south line produced 160 feet more or less to a point in the west bank of the Salinas River, being the Easterly City Boundary of the City of El Paso de Robles; thence northerly and easterly along said East City Boundary to the true point of beginning.

SECTION 2: That said territory hereby is designated and identified for such election purposes and for use upon the ballots at such election as "Annexation No. 8".

SECTION 3: Notice is hereby given that on the 16th day of March, 1959, at the hour of 8:00 P. M., in the Council Chamber of the City Hall of the City of El Paso de Robles, any person owning real property within said territory so proposed to be annexed and having any objection to the proposed annexation may appear before said city council and show cause why such territory should not be so annexed. Such protest must be in writing and shall state the name or names of the owner or owners of the property affected by such annexation and the location and area of such property in general terms. If it be found that protest is not made by owners of a majority of the separate parcels of property within the territory proposed to be annexed, further proceedings shall be taken in accordance with the law for the holding of such special election.

SECTION 4: That the City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this resolution and cause the same to be published in The Paso Robles Press once a week for the two weeks prior to the said hearing.
