

RESOLUTION NO. 1099

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION FOR VACATING AND CLOSING
OAK STREET BETWEEN TWENTY-SIXTH STREET AND TWENTY-
EIGHTH STREET AND GIVING NOTICE OF TIME AND PLACE
FOR HEARING THEREON.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES DOES HEREBY
RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

1. That it is the intention of said City Council to close and vacate
for street purposes a portion of Oak Street in the City of El Paso de Robles,
County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, which is particularly de-
scribed as follows:

Beginning at the South line of 28th Street and extending Southerly
155 feet, more or less, to that portion of Oak Street already closed.

2. That Monday, April 20, 1959, at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M. on
said date, in the City Council Chambers of the City Hall, Paso Robles,
California, is the time and place for hearing all persons interested in or
having objections to the proposed closing and vacation.

3. That the City Clerk of the City of El Paso de Robles be and he is
hereby directed to cause a copy of this Resolution of Intention to be pub-
lished at least once a week for three weeks prior to the date set herein
for hearing in the Paso Robles Press, a newspaper of general circulation,
published and circulated in the City of El Paso de Robles.

4. That the Director of Public Works of the City of El Paso de Robles
be and he is hereby directed to cause a notice of the passage of this Res-
olution of Intention and the time and place of hearing by conspicuously
posting notices thereof along the line of the street proposed to be closed
and vacated.

5. That in the event of said closing, as hereinabove described, the
City of El Paso de Robles will reserve a permanent easement for the install-
ation, maintenance, repair or replacement of sewer lines, water lines and
drainage facilities in said closed area and ingress and egress for said purpose.
