

RESOLUTION NO. 1119

RESOLUTION RENAMING SOFTBALL PARK

WHEREAS, the City of El Paso de Robles has for many years past operated a softball diamond located at Block 106 in this City; and

WHEREAS, the late William Robbins dedicated to this City all of Block 92 and a portion of Block 93 in this City for a municipal baseball field known as ROBBINS FIELD; and


WHEREAS, the construction of the U. S. Highway 101 by-pass has destroyed Robbins Field, for which the State of California paid a cash consideration to this City for a right of way in said blocks; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and desirable to install new stands, fencing, and lights at the softball diamond, and to use the funds received from Robbins Field to pay for said improvements;

BE AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the funds received by the City from the State for the highway right of way through Robbins Field be utilized to replace the grandstands, fencing, and improve the lighting system of the City baseball park; and

RESOLVED FURTHER that said baseball diamond be renamed "ROBBINS FIELD" in honor of William L. Robbins.
