

RESOLUTION NO. 1123

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO VACATE AN ALLEY
IN THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES AND GIVING
NOTICE OF TIME AND PLACE OF HEARING THEREON

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES DOES HEREBY RESOLVE
AS FOLLOWS:

1. That it is the intention of said City Council to close and vacate an alley in the City of El Paso de Robles, County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, which is particularly described as follows:


The alley, 24 feet in width and 270 feet long, lying between Blocks 8 and 9 as shown on map of T. H. McFarlain's Resubdivision of Villa Lots, 3, 4, 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11 in Riverside Farm No.6, Paso Robles, filed in the office of the County Recorder of San Luis Obispo County on June 30, 1888.

2. That Monday, August 3, 1959, at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M. on said date, in the City Council Chamber of the City Hall, Paso Robles, California, is the time and place for hearing all persons interested in or having any objections to the proposed closing and vacation.

3. That the City Clerk of the City of El Paso de Robles be and he is hereby directed to cause a copy of this Resolution of Intention to be published at least once a week for three weeks prior to the date set herein for hearing in the Paso Robles, Press, a newspaper of general circulation, published and circulated in the City of El Paso de Robles.

4. That the Director of Public Works of the City of El Paso de Robles be and he is hereby directed to cause a notice of the passage of this Resolution of Intention and the time and place of hearing by conspicuously posting notices thereof along the line of the alley proposed to be closed and vacated, as required by law.
