

RESOLUTION No. 1133

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES TO
THE PRESIDING JUDGE OF THE SUPERIOR COURT OF THE STATE OF
CALIFORNIA, IN AND FOR THE COUNTY OF SAN LUIS OBISPO, AND
TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF SAID COUNTY.

WHEREAS, the rapid growth in population and its attendant legal business both civil and criminal has been recognized by the Legislature of the State of California, by its establishment of the Second Department of the Superior Court of the State of California, in the County of San Luis Obispo; and

WHEREAS, there are six attorneys actively practicing law in the City of El Paso de Robles and two additional attorneys actively practicing law in Atascadero; and

WHEREAS, the volume of legal business being handled in Northern and Eastern San Luis Obispo County is keeping pace with our county-wide growth; and

WHEREAS, there would be a great convenience and saving of time for the residents of San Luis Obispo County to have a Department of said Superior Court sit in Northern San Luis Obispo County to hear probate, law and motion, and default matters at least one day out of each two weeks; and

WHEREAS, this system has been utilized successfully and to the convenience of the residents of our adjoining County of Santa Barbara where a branch of the Superior Court hears such matters in the City of Santa Maria; and

WHEREAS, the Council Chamber of the City Hall of the City of El Paso de Robles is available during normal court hours for the purpose of conducting Court therein; and

WHEREAS, the City of El Paso de Robles wishes to accommodate the residents of Northern and Eastern San Luis Obispo County by making available the Council Chambers and its

adjacent facilities;


BE AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council
of the City of El Paso de Robles:

1. That the City Council tenders at no charge
to the County of San Luis Obispo the use of the City Council
Chambers and adjacent facilities for the purpose of conducting
a Superior Court Room therein;

2. That the City Council respectfully requests the
presiding Superior Court Judge in the County of San Luis Obispo
and the Honorable Board of Supervisors of said County to enter
the appropriate resolutions and orders causing a branch of the
Superior Court to sit in Paso Robles for the purpose of hearing
probate, law and motion, and default matters at intervals con-
venient to the Honorable Court but not less than once each
two weeks;


3. That the City Administrator is hereby directed

B. Lyon, presiding Judge therein.
