

RESOLUTION NO. 1357

RESOLUTION OBJECTING TO REDISTRICTING OF SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY

WHEREAS it has just been brought to the attention of the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles that the Southern-Pacific Association of the Amateur Athletics Union has proposed that the County of San Luis Obispo, California, be transferred from the jurisdiction of the Southern-Pacific Association to the Central California Association; and

WHEREAS no advance notice of this proposal was given this City or its A.A.U. Affiliate prior to its introduction of the resolution.

WHEREAS this City has for many years sponsored the Paso Robles Roblettes, a nationally known synchronized swimming organization, an active registered member of the Southern-Pacific Association of A.A.U.; and

WHEREAS the Paso Robles Roblettes have produced numerous class and regional synchronized swimming champions in solo, in duets, and in team competition, and in addition has produced Roberta Armstrong, the National Indoor and Outdoor Women's Synchronized Solo Champion and gold medal winner in the Pan-American Games; and

WHEREAS the Paso Robles Roblettes represents the only active A.A.U. Affiliate in the County of San Luis Obispo and has always enjoyed excellent working relationships with the Southern-Pacific Association; and

WHEREAS it is believed by the officials of this City that the proposed transfer is not in the best interest of competitive A.A.U. sponsored and affiliated activities of the County of San Luis Obispo;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY  
THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES AS FOLLOWS:

1. That this City is opposed to the redistricting  
of the County of San Luis Obispo, and transferring same out  
of the Southern-Pacific jurisdiction;

2. That this City respectfully requests the  
Southern-Pacific Association to reconsider the proposed  
redistricting; and in this regard Mr. James A. Madden, City  
Attorney is authorized and requested to appear before the  
next meeting of the Southern-Pacific Association to register  
this protest;

3. That this City respectfully requests the A.A.U.,  
at its National Convention in Huston, Texas in December 1964  
to reject at this time the proposed redistricting of San Luis  
Obispo County.
