

RESOLUTION NO. 1114

A RESOLUTION CLOSING A PORTION OF A STREET
IN THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, having on the 20th day of November, 1967, passed a Resolution of Intention to vacate and close a portion of the former County Road No. 91 (now called Creston Road) a public street in the City of El Paso de Robles, County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, which is particularly described as follows:

(a) That portion of Creston Road that lies between the northerly line of Lot 15 in Rancho Santa Ysabel and the southerly line of the established Creston Road Plan Line as recorded June 30, 1965, in Book 14 at Page 88 of Licensed Surveys.

(b) That portion of Creston Road that lies between the northerly line of Lot 28 in Olive Park Tract and the southerly line of the established Creston Road Plan Line as recorded June 30, 1965, in Book 14 at Page 88 of Licensed Surveys.

Parcels (a) and (b) as being included in one unit is more particularly described as follows:

Starting at Post SY112 in the center line of former County Road No. 91 (now called Creston Road); thence N $50^{\circ} 45'$ W along said center line in a westerly direction 106.75 feet; thence S $39^{\circ} 15'$ W $20+$ feet to a point on the Creston Road Plan Line as recorded June 30, 1965, as the point of beginning - Continuing from said point of beginning S $39^{\circ} 15'$ W $10+$ feet to the northerly property line of Lot 15 in Rancho Santa Ysabel; thence S $50^{\circ} 45'$ E $115+$ feet to the easterly line of Lot 15 in Rancho Santa Ysabel; thence S $72^{\circ} 25'$ E $96+$ feet to the intersection of the southerly Plan Line of Creston Road; thence following said southerly line of the Plan Line in a westerly direction on a 1042 foot radius concave to the north to the point of beginning.

WHEREAS, it now appears that the City Clerk of the City of El Paso de Robles did cause said Resolution of Intention to be published in the Paso Robles Daily Press as required by law; and

WHEREAS, it also appears that the Director of Public Works for the City of El Paso de Robles did cause notices to be posted along said street as required by law; and

WHEREAS, it further appears that said notices and publications were in all respects as required by the provisions of an act of the Legislature of the State of California entitled, "Street Vacation Act of 1941"; Division IX, Part 3, Chapters 1 and 2 of the Streets and Highways Code; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing has been held on said proposed closing as so noticed and having heard all evidence offered by any person interested, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles finds that the street as described is unnecessary for present and prospective future public street purposes.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the public street easement cease on said portion of Creston Road hereinbefore described and be vacated for public street purposes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk of the City of El Paso de Robles cause a certified copy of this Resolution to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder of San Luis Obispo County, State of California.
