

RESOLUTION NO. 1473

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES  
FOR TEEN-AGE REPRESENTATION ON THE PARK & RECREATION ADVISORY  
COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the City Council deems the interests and ideas of the youth of our City to be an important element in the shaping of the growth and development of our community recreation and parks facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to have the young people of the City of Paso Robles actively involved in local governmental affairs and especially in those programs largely participated in by the teenage members of the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

1. A plan is hereby adopted to provide for the appointment of a teenage representative of the community as a member of the Park and Recreation Advisory Committee.

2. The seventh member of the Committee shall be a high school student who will be appointed for the term of one (1) year commencing on September 1st of each year.

3. Qualifications for the teenage representative are:

- a. Be either a young man or woman.
- b. Be a senior during his term of office.
- c. Be a resident of the Paso Robles High School District.
- d. In addition, individual selection should consider the following:
  - (1) Record of attendance and promptness.
  - (2) Attitude.
  - (3) Appearance and neatness.
  - (4) Suitable representative and spokesman for teenagers.
  - (5) Record of community participation and involvement.
- e. Recommendation of the High School Principal.


4. Teenage members term of office:

The teenager appointment will be by the City Council for a one year term from September 1 through August 31 and serve at the pleasure of the City Council.


5. Status of appointment:

The teenage member so appointed shall have full membership status on the Committee and be subject to the rules and regulations governing the Park and Recreation Advisory Committee.
