

RESOLUTION NO. 1484

RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 1479
REQUESTING EMERGENCY DISASTER ASSISTANCE

WHEREAS, on the 26th day of January, 1969, the President declared a "major disaster" in the State of California under the provisions of Public Law 875, 81st Congress, as amended; and,

WHEREAS, San Luis Obispo County Flood Control and Water Conservation District is a public entity within said State; and,

WHEREAS, the City of El Paso de Robles is a public entity within said District;

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles by Resolution No. 1479 requested the Board of Supervisors of the San Luis Obispo County Flood Control and Water Conservation District to request the Office of Emergency Preparedness to arrange to have the appropriate Federal Agency provide emergency disaster assistance essential to the health, safety or welfare of the people and property of this public entity; and,

WHEREAS, the City of El Paso de Robles sustained substantial damage from the storm occurring during the period of February 22 to February 24, 1969; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to amend the original request to include additional items of work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles that the Board of Supervisors of San Luis Obispo County Flood Control and Water Conservation District, State of California, be and hereby is requested to request that the Office of Emergency Preparedness be requested to arrange to have the appropriate Federal Agency provide the following emergency disaster assistance essential to the health, safety or welfare of the people and property of this public entity:

6. Repair 8-inch water supply line crossing Salinas River near Niblick Road (This line is located immediately south of the water supply line referred to in Item 2 of said Resolution No. 1479).
7. Provide slope protection along the east bank of the Salinas River, between the 13th Street Bridge and the South City Limits, where necessary to protect the South River Road.
8. Restore two additional municipal wells, treatment facilities, and appurtenances at the Ronconi site near the South City Limits.

The foregoing work is requested in addition to that requested by Resolution No. 1479, dated February 3, 1969.

This body certifies that, to the best of its knowledge and belief, the requested work is eligible under Public Law 875, 81st Congress, as amended, and agrees to (a) provide without cost to the United States all lands, easements, and rights-of-way necessary for accomplishment of the approved work; and (b) hold and save the United States free from damages due to the approved work.
