RESOLUTION REQUESTING FEASIBILITY STUDY OF PROPOSED HIGHWAY


WHEREAS, the City of Coalinga has requested the State Division of Highways to conduct studies to determine the feasibility of the construction of a new highway, or relocation of the existing highway to provide a more direct access from the vicinity of Coalinga to the Paso Robles area; and

WHEREAS, studies by the City of El Paso de Robles confirm the fact that large population centers such as Fresno, and other areas in Fresno County would be greatly assisted by having a new and direct route opened between Coalinga and Paso Robles, so as to make the recreational areas in the County of San Luis Obispo more accessible to the upper San Joaquin Valley population.

BE AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles as follows:

That the State Division of Highways immediately commence feasibility studies in keeping with the foregoing recitals, and recommend to the State Highway Commission the earliest construction of a highway directly connecting the Coalinga and Paso Robles areas.


