

RESOLUTION NO. 1486

RESOLUTION TO THE CORPS OF ENGINEERS REQUESTING EMERGENCY
ASSISTANCE

WHEREAS, the domestic water system of the City of El Paso de Robles was severely damaged during the recent flooding of the Salinas River, causing destruction of four (4) wells and adjacent water transmission lines and adjacent water treatment plant; and

WHEREAS, the channel of the Salinas River moved during the flooding, making it mandatory to relocate a substitute water source through the drilling of a new well and construction of a water treatment plant and water transmission main; and good cause appearing therefor,

BE AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles as follows:

1. That the Corps of Engineers of the United States Army be requested to immediately replace the wells destroyed, and drill one or more wells to produce an equivalent amount of domestic water for the City's municipally owned water system;
2. That the necessary water transmission lines of a size of 16", or larger, be installed to tie in with the existing water transmission system;
3. That the necessary water treatment plant facilities be constructed, all to replace the water facilities lost in the recent flooding.


Upon motion made by Councilman Oeck, seconded by Councilman Barnhart, and on the following roll call vote, to-wit:


