RESOLUTION IN OPPOSITION OF SENATE BILL 1414

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles has just had the opportunity of studying Senate Bill 1414, as amended; and


WHEREAS, said bill, if passed, will in large measure destroy the traditional legislative and executive powers of cities and counties in engaging, managing, funding, and promoting police officers and members of the Sheriff's office, and other police officers of any local government within the State of California; and

WHEREAS, this City is unalterably opposed to fixing salaries and ranges of salaries for local employees or officers by the State Legislature; and good cause appearing therefor,

BE AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles as follows:

1. That this City opposes the passage of Senate Bill 1414;
2. That the City Clerk of this City be directed to forward copies of this resolution to all members of the Senate Committee on Finance, as well as to the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Luis Obispo.
